- Payroll in a large church may average 40% of budget; 60% in a small church
- Debt should be no more than 25% of budget
- Total building expense should be no more than 30% of budget
- Minimum of 10-20% of budget should go to missions outside of church
- Maintain 3-6 months of reserves

For example, a church with an average worship attendance of 100 should average at least \$2,600 in weekly budget giving. This ratio is obviously greatly impacted by demographics. Maximum debt payment budgeted : 33 percent of annual income for most churches.
